**LITTLETON COUNCIL MEMBER JAMES A. TAYLOR ELECTED DRCOG CHAIR**

**Feb. 17, 2011 (Denver, Colorado)** – Littleton Council Member James A. Taylor was elected chair of the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG) Board of Directors at the Board's Feb. 16 meeting. He is the fifth chair in the organization's 56-year history to come from Littleton. Other Littleton leaders who served at DRCOG's helm include Dennis S. Reynolds in 1994, Robert L. Tonsing in 1988 and 1989, Thomas E. Kristopeit in 1972, and Varian L. Ashbaugh in 1961.

Joining Taylor in leading the regional council in 2011 are Broomfield Council Member Dennis McCloskey as vice chair, Bennett Mayor Sue Horn as secretary, and Douglas County Commissioner Jack Hilbert as treasurer. Arapahoe County Commissioner Rod Bockenfeld is immediate past chair.

Taylor has represented Littleton on the DRCOG Board of Directors since 2007, and served as the alternate before that. In addition, he previously held the posts of DRCOG vice chair (2010), secretary (2009) and treasurer (2008).

The council of governments is a nonprofit collaborative association of 56 county and municipal governments in the Denver region working together to make life better.
