14	WHEREAS, the city council established the City of Littleton Stormwater and
15 16	Flood Management Utility Enterprise (the "Enterprise") by Ordinance No. 33, Series of 2013; and
17	WHEREAS, the city council, as the governing board of the Enterprise, has the
18	authority under said ordinance to establish the budget for the Enterprise; and
19	authority under said ordinance to establish the budget for the Enterprise, and
20	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 29, Series of 2021 established the budgeted
21	expenditures for the City of Littleton Stormwater and Flood Management Utility Enterprise; and

24	Enterprise could not have been reasonably anticipated during the time of adoption of this budget

32	31, 2022 are hereby amended by the following addition:

38	Section 2: The total budgeted expenditures for the City of Littleton, Colorado, of
