## **IMAGINE**

Artist Kalliopi Monoyios uses single-use plastic food wrappers in her artwork. By creating beauty from a commonly used material that society treats as disposable, she questions the perceived value of plastic. Despite issues caused by its long afterlife and environmental toll, plastic is a unique material that makes modern life efficient and comfortable.

As a work of fine art, or a treasured heirloom such as a quilt, plastic becomes something treated with admiration, like a precious resource.
