7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
8 COLORADO, APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO AN
9 EXISTING FIVE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH
10 CARTEGRAPH SYSTEMS LLC FOR AN ENTERPRISE
11 ASSET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

13 WHEREAS, the City of Littleton owns and operates a large network of public
14 infrastructure; and

15
16 WHEREAS, an enterprise asset management system is a critical tool in
17 documenting the condition and maintenance activities on the city’s infrastructure; and

18
19 WHEREAS, an enterprise asset management system will aid in improving
20 operational efficiency and will provide data to support the development of long-term capital
21 improvement plans; and

23 WHEREAS, city staff believe Cartegraph will be a platform that will meet our
24 needs for many years to come; and

27 WHEREAS, the original agreement needs to be amended to increase the cost of
28 the agreement and allow for addition of 25 licenses for use across all divisions utilizing the
29 software; and

31 WHEREAS, funding for this purchase will be programmed into the annual budget.

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
34 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

36 **Section 1:** Council approves the amendment to the existing five-year term for the
37 enterprise asset management system contract with Cartegraph Systems LLC.

39 **Section 2:** Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase
40 of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of
41 the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have
42 passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof,
43 irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases
44 may be declared invalid.

46 **Section 3:** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict

47 with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer
48 clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

51 INTRODUCED AS A BILL at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council
52 of the City of Littleton on the 5th day of April 2022, passed on first reading by a vote of 7 FOR
53 and 0 AGAINST; and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center, Bemis Library, the
54 Municipal Courthouse and on the City of Littleton Website.

55 PUBLIC HEARING on the Ordinance to take place on the 19th day of April, 2022,
56 in the Council Chamber, Littleton Center, 2255 West Berry Avenue, Littleton, Colorado, at the
57 hour of 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as it may be heard.
