9 COLORADO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 36 SERIES OF
10 2020 KNOWN AS THE “ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL”

17 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 36, Series of 2020 established the annual
18 appropriation for municipal purposes for the City of Littleton, Colorado; and

20 WHEREAS, appropriations have theretofore been made for the expenditures of
21 monies pursuant to said budget; and

23 WHEREAS, the necessity of receiving and expending additional monies from the
24 general funds could not have been reasonably anticipated during the time of the adoption
25 of the budget and appropriation of funds in accordance therewith.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
28 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

30 Section 1: The budget of the City of Littleton for the fiscal year beginning January
31 1, 2021, and ending December 31, 2021, is hereby amended by the following addition:

<u>FUND</u>	<u>EXPENDITURE</u>
General Fund	\$ 136,800

36 Section 2: The provisions of the annual appropriations Ordinance No. 36, Series of
37 2020, are hereby amended with the total of all fund expenditures amended to \$67,484,490.

39 Section 3: Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or
40 phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the
41 validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would
42 have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase
43 hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or
44 phrases may be declared invalid.

46 Section 4: Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict
47 with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer
48 clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

52 of the City of Littleton on the 1st day of December, 2020, passed on first reading by a vote of 7
53 FOR and 0 AGAINST; and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center, Bemis Library,

56 2020, in the Council Chamber¹, Littleton Center, 2255 West Berry Avenue, Littleton, Colorado,
57 at the hour of 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as it may be heard.
